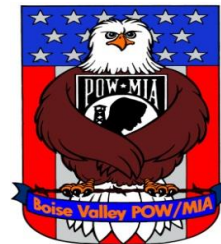

## American's Accounted for:

May 1<sup>st</sup> update from National League of Families:

There are now 1,627 personnel listed by the Department of Defense as missing and unaccounted for from the Vietnam War

Apr's & May's spotlight is on the following

Idahoans: At the end of the Vietnam War, twelve Idahoans were listed as POW/MIA. Since then four of the twelve have been recovered and repatriated with full Military Honors.

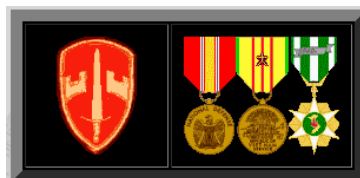

- ❖ Warhawk Museum Vietnam 50th Anniversary Symposium Part 4 June 20, 2015 Sessions are free to the public and run from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. Museum will open early at 9:30 a.m. Symposium Part 4 is about the Helicopter War. It will

cover the development, modifications, and importance of the helicopter to fill the need in Vietnam. Because of the significance of the Huey, special guest speakers will cover the importance and missions of Slicks (B, D & H model Huey Helicopters), Guns (C model Huey), and DUST OFF. Speakers will also discuss helicopters other than the Huey that were used in the war by the Army, Navy, Marines and Air Force. This will include Heavy Lift, Observation, Crash Rescue (Jolly Green Giant) and the helicopters of the early war. There will be a slide show and brief discussion of helicopters used in Vietnam and their mission. There will be a Q&A session at the conclusion. The film "Shadow of the Blade" will be shown following the conclusion of the program.
